

Brand New Book ***** Print on Demand *****.The Internet Tax Freedom Act (ITFA), enacted in October 1998 and extended for two years in November 2001, expired on November 1, 2003 . The federal moratorium prohibited state and local governments from levying new taxes on Internet access and any multiple or discriminatory taxes on electronic commerce . Taxes on Internet access that were in place before October 1, 1998, were protected by a grandfather clause. The House approved H.R. 49 by voice vote, under a suspension of the rules, on September 17, 2003. H .R. 49 as passed would (1) permanently extend the moratorium; (2) eliminate the grandfathering protections, and (3) exempt from state and local taxes any form of telecommunications used to provide Internet access . The bill introduced by Representative Cox was replaced by a technical amendment in the Subcommittee on Commercial and Administrative Law and further amended by the Judiciary Committee to provide for neutrality in the tax ban across all modes of Internet access. The Congressional Budget Office (CBO) found that H.R. 49 would impose an intergovernmental mandate because existing taxes would not be granted grandfathering protection.
