

The California Department of Fish and Game in cooperation with Moss Landing Marine Laboratories conducted bimonthly surveys along a fixed transect in Monterey Bay through 1975. The Department tried to continue these surveys on a monthly basis but other priorities prevented surveys from being made after the end of May 1976. Point Reyes Bird Observatory makes weekly censuses of birds in the Gulf of the Farallones. California State University, Humboldt, conducts regular offshore surveys out of Eureka. The R. V. Alaska (Cal. F and G) records sightings of marine birds as the interest of the scientists permits. The Department personnel have censused offshore birds monthly in Morro Bay since the spring of 1975.
